**NOTIFICATIONS**

*Islamabad, the 15th March, 2010*

**S. R. O. 175 (1)/2010.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 56 of the Competition Ordinance, 2009, the Competition Commission of Pakistan (the Commission), is pleased to make the following amendments in (i) the Competition Commission (General Enforcement) Regulations, 2007 and (ii) the Competition Commission (Service) Regulations, 2007, namely:—

**1. The Competition Commission (General Enforcement) Regulations, 2007.**

In the aforesaid regulations,—

“The existing clause (a) of sub-regulation (2) of regulation 26 of the said regulations, shall be substituted with the following:—

**1. Presentation of case:**

- (i). The parties concerned or their duly authorized representative shall be asked to present their case and to produce relevant oral and/or

documentary evidences forming the basis for issuance of show cause notice.

- (ii) The parties shall appoint only such representatives to appear before the Commission on their behalf who are fully briefed so as to be conversant in all respects with the facts and issues of the matter being heard as well as the status of the undertaking and are duly authorized to make statements or commitments for and on their behalf in relation thereto and can respond to any or all queries made by the adjudicating authority in respect thereof.”
